






## TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SPECIAL OPS JULY 2024 – SEPTEMBER 2024

#### OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA JULY 2024 - SEPTEMBER 2024









## TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SOLID WASTE JULY 2024 – SEPTEMBER 2024

# OVERALL % OF SPECIAL OPS CASES BY SLA JULY 2024 - SEPTEMBER 2024









# TOP 4 REQUESTED SERVICES – SWEET JULY 2024 – SEPTEMBER 2024










