



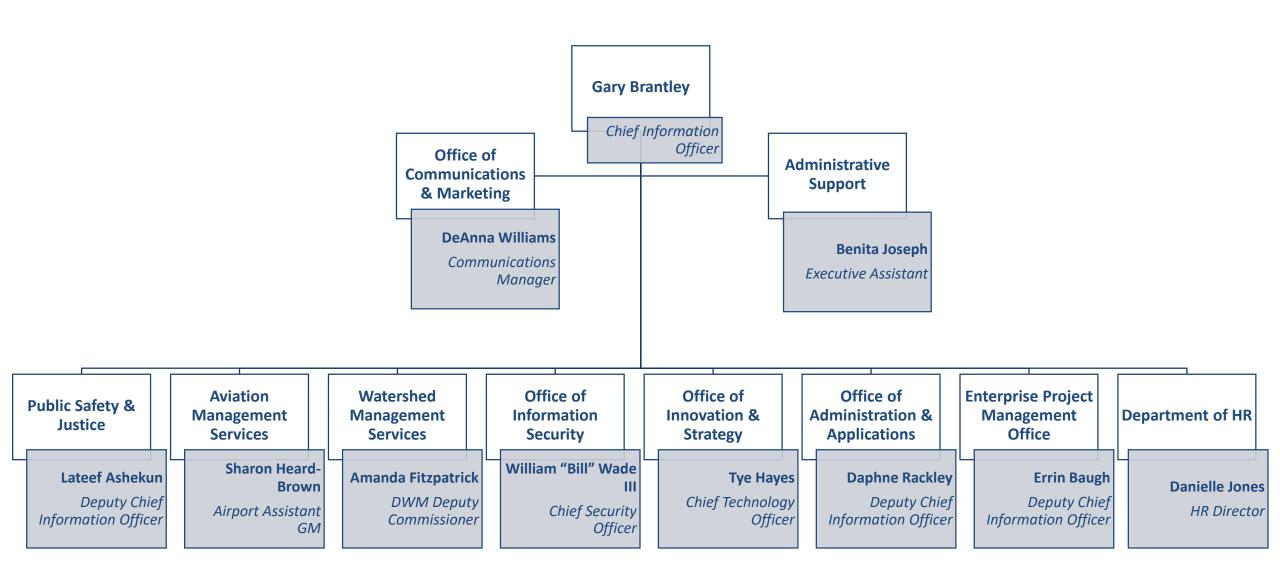

Organizational Structure - Executive Team

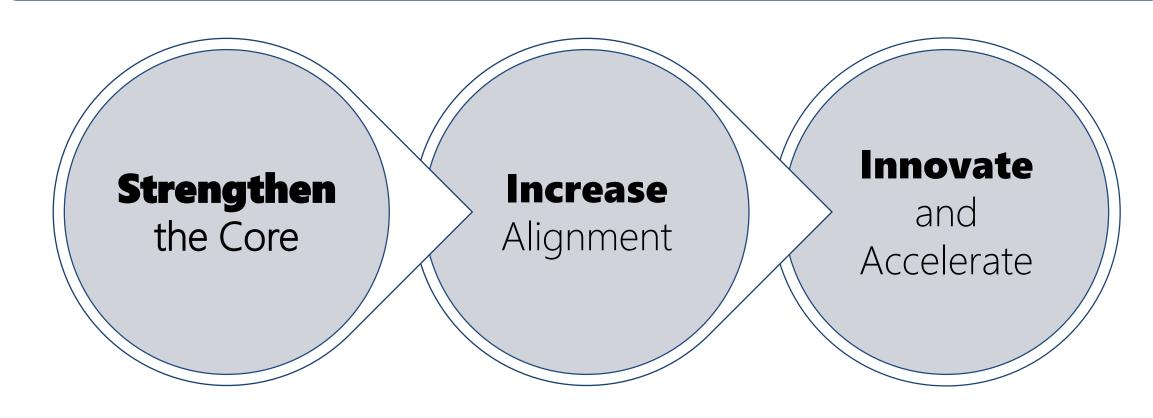




The Roadmap

Printer Management Services

- The Printer Management Services program consists of the implementation of <u>396</u> new Xerox devices.
- Moreover, this program will deliver best in class services and technology to our output environment, which includes copiers, printers, faxes and scanners.

- ✓ Consolidation candidates



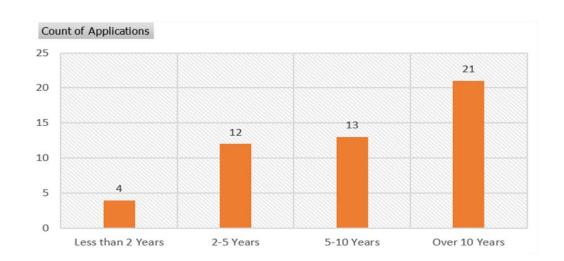
Applications are delivering good business value despite poor technical condition/platform.

- ✓ Sponsor a replacement or alternative

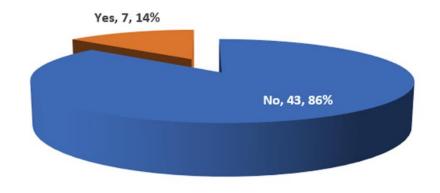


Applications reflect good technical condition and high business value.
