PROPOSED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) New Provisions

- From two IGAs to one IGA considering both Economic and Redevelopment Services
- Both Services are on a 5-year term
- Incentives should support Principal Objectives
- A clear vision focused on economic mobility and equity
- Outcomes and measures will be established and reported to the City
- Implementation of the procurement recommendations of the 2019 Disparity Study
- Salary survey information included to ensure IA is competitive and in line with City and industry standards

PROPOSED IGA New Provisions

REDEVELOPMENT SERVICES

- Any single TAD expenditure for contracted services, professional services, or other agreements, in excess of \$100,000 shall first be approved by the Invest Atlanta Board of Directors
- Every three years, IA will have an appropriate third-party consultant evaluate the completion status of the Redevelopment Plans
- Once the consultant determines a Redevelopment Plan for a TAD has been substantially completed, IA will
 advise the City to adopt legislation directing that surplus funds be used to pay all other outstanding
 redevelopment costs in full, retire outstanding debt and adopt subsequent legislation terminating the TAD

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

- Implementation of three new loan funds: Atlanta Forward Loan Fund, Creative Industries Loan Fund and other loan funds that support non-traditional business models
- Implementation and reporting for the City's Women's Entrepreneurship Initiative



PROPOSED IGA PRINCIPAL OBJECTIVES

- 1. Create healthy, vibrant neighborhoods in all parts of Atlanta
- 2. Facilitate access to high-quality employment for all Atlantans
- 3. Foster wealth creation and neighborhood capacity building within underserved communities
- 4. Participate in regional collaboration related to workforce development in high-demand occupations
- 5. Partner with sister agencies, non-profits, and community groups to produce, retain and expand long-term or permanent affordable housing throughout the City in a variety of types

Enterprise, Atlanta Urban League, APD-Urban with Bloomberg servicing as a Consultant to IA




ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY BASED ON ECONOMIC MOBILITY DEFINING THE NORTH STAR






