



Category of Grant Awards




The majority of the proposals funded were Community Development, followed by Affordable Housing, and Job Training.

Neighborhood Distribution




Percentage Funded by Dollars Requested

Week of February 2nd

 The recommendations will be presented to the full CD/HS Committee for approval.

Week of March 1st

 The recommendations will be presented to the full Atlanta City Council for approval.

Week of March 16th

The mayor issues a resolution.

Week of March 23rd

 The Trust project team will send out official grant award announcements.
