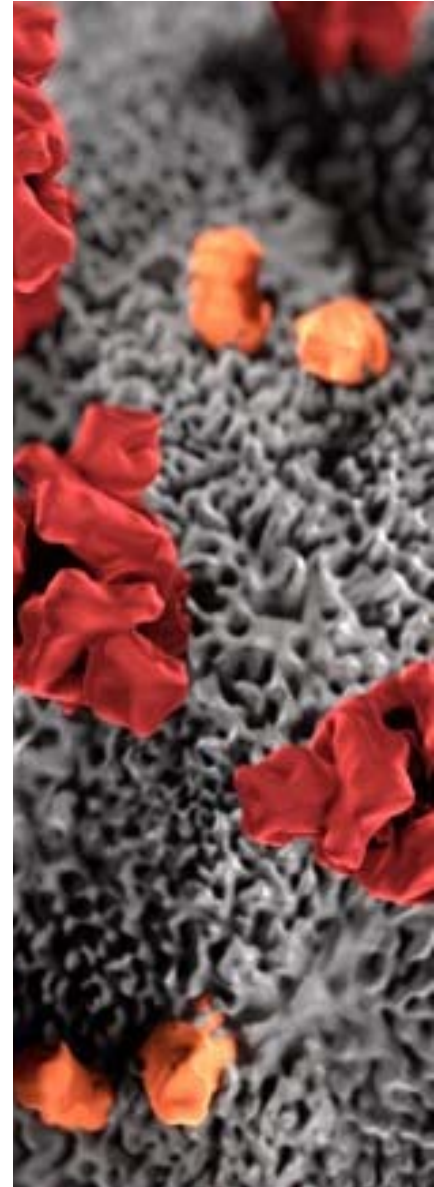


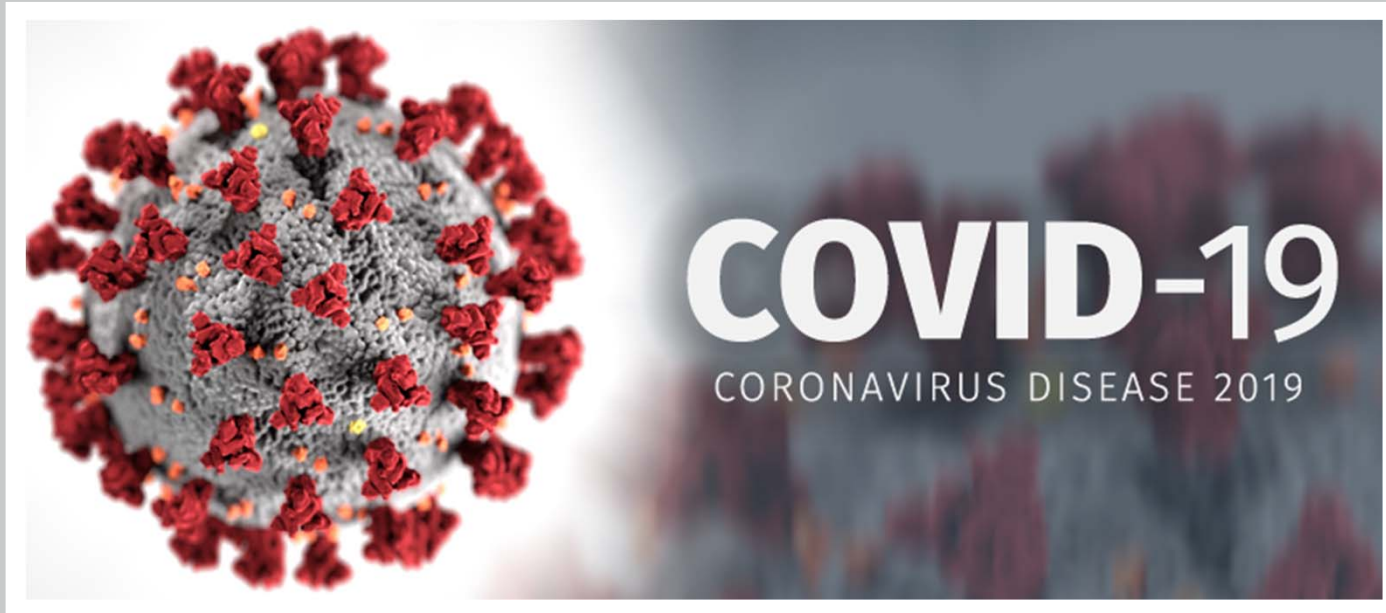

Updates as of March 10, 2020

- Number of Cases Worldwide: 115,825
- Number of Cases in Georgia: 17
- Number of Cases in the Metro Atlanta Area: 15
