

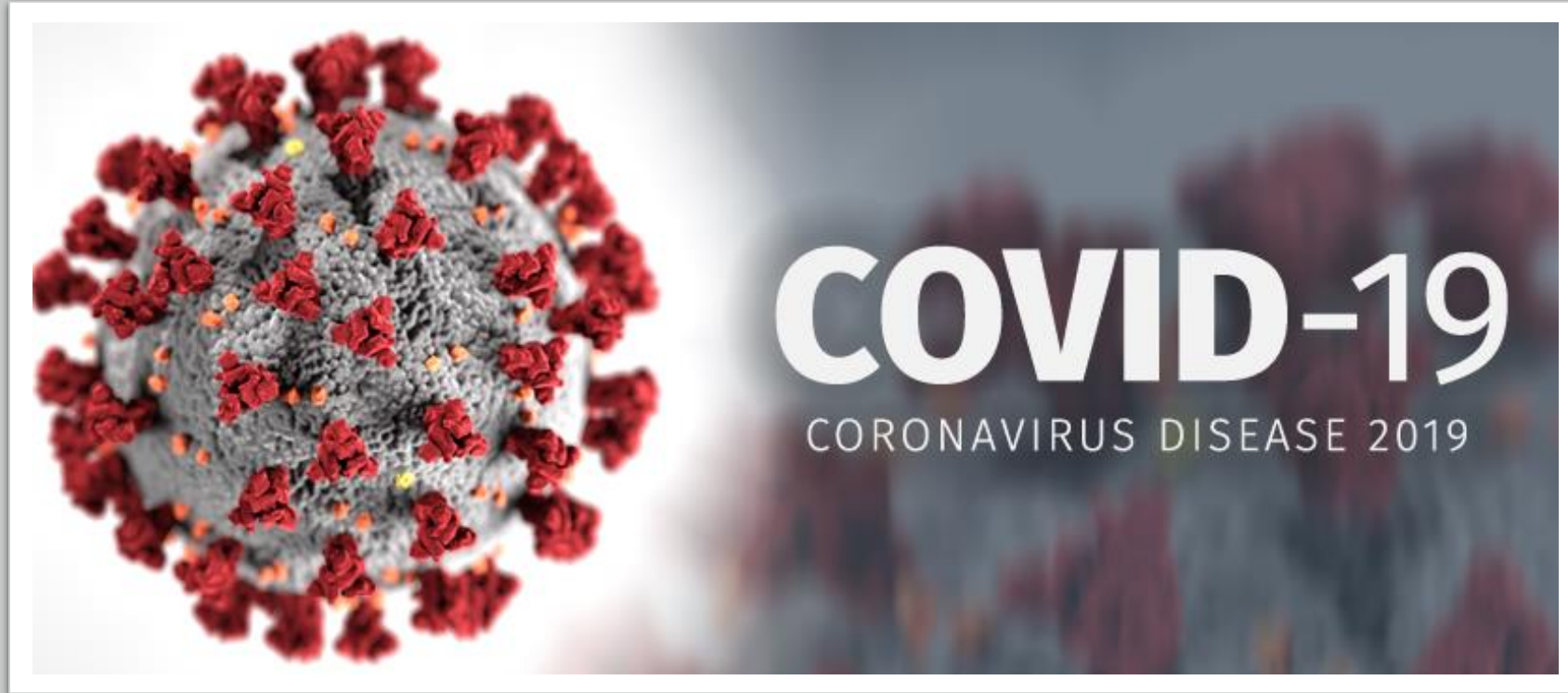

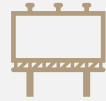
# *COVID-19 Prevention Messages and Resources*
