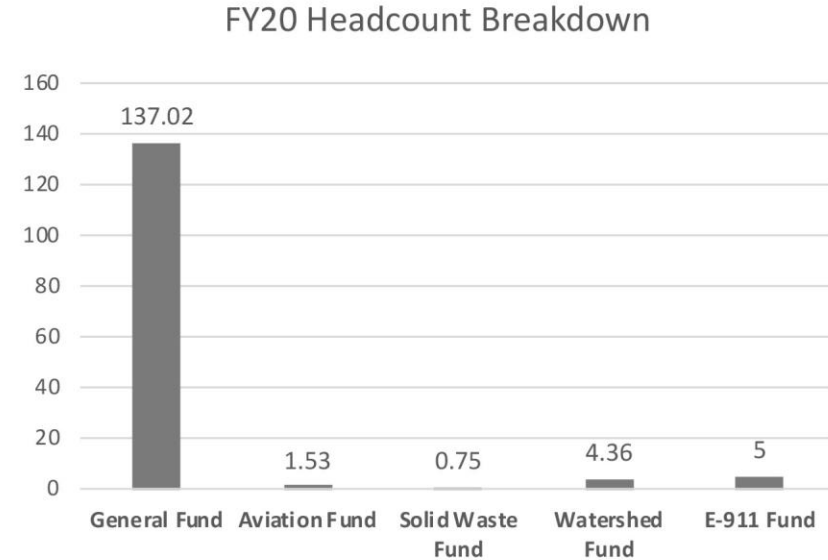
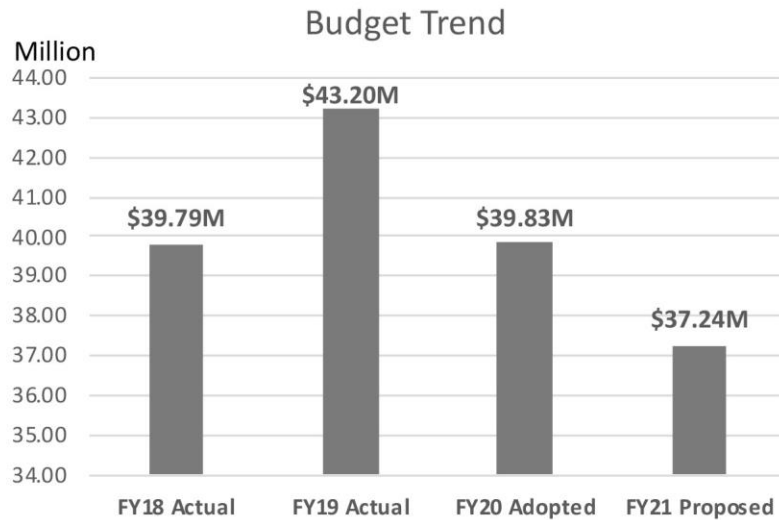

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# SUMMARY OF CURRENT OPERATIONS



## > OPERATIONAL AREAS

1. Infrastructure Enhancements
2. Application Enhancements
3. Security Enhancements

## > KEY METRICS

1. Implemented network bandwidth and implemented network segmentation
2. Implemented solutions that provide improved productivity and collaboration
3. Implemented multi-factor and rigorous scanning and remediation program

# FY20 HIGHLIGHTS

## INFRASTRUCTURE ENHANCEMENTS

- > Segregated Guest wireless, internet bandwidth increase, telework remote capability, rebuilt service desk AIM now.

## APPLICATION ENHANCEMENTS

- > Citynet, consolidation of airport email with city , docuSign paperless environment, and microsoft teams.

## SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS

- > Network Segmentation, Multi Factor, Legacy devices removed from Environment, and Strengthened policies.





# PROPOSED BUDGET CHANGES

The Department of Atlanta Information Management's proposed budget decrease is a total of \$1.6million dollars for Fy'21.

The budget decreases primarily affect two areas: Personnel and Professional Services (O&M)

> Personnel - \$250,000 decrease

> Professional Services - \$1,300,000 decrease



# PROPOSED OPERATIONAL CHANGES

Security- \$800,000 operational impact

## Operational changes

- Onboarding of Security resources to provide citywide coverage
- Implementation of Security vulnerability scanning application to reduce risk to city infrastructure (servers, applications, databases)
- Cancellation of 5 security subscriptions/contracts
- Re-negotiating of contract terms and services for contract renewals
- Split-funding of security expenses for city-wide support

Infrastructure- \$500,000 operational impact

## Operational changes

- Implemented phase I of Network Segmentation to reduce intrusion risk to the city's infrastructure
- Contract re-negotiations for contract renewals
- Delayed expansion of Network Segmentation (Phase 2 project has been suspended)

Personnel- \$250,000

## Operational changes

- Re-assessing in-house critical positions to better align resources to support IT service needs for Fy'21
