



Proposed Budget Changes



Personnel Budget Changes

- \$840,000 REDUCTION IN PERSONNEL BUDGET
- One transfer to Department of Parks and Recreation (Summer Foods)
- Two transfers to Department of Grants and Community
 Development
- Net reduction of seven positions due to vacancies not being funded

Operating Budget Changes

- \$700,000 REDUCTION IN OPERATING BUDGET
- Each division's operating budget reduced by an equal percentage (approx. 10%)
- Allocation transfer to Department of Grants and Community Development




