\*\*\*\*A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBER ANTONIO BROWN URGING THE GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REVIEW AND REVISE ITS STATUTES RELATED TO SEARCHES WITH WARRANTS, (TITLE 17, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 2, SECTIONS 17-5-20 THROUGH 17-5-32 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED) TO SPECIFICALLY BAN THE USE OF NO-KNOCK WARRANTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.(FAVORABLE BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE 8/24/20)

WHEREAS, searches with warrants by Georgia Certified Peace Officers are governed by state law, generally (Title 17, Chapter 5, Article 2, Sections 17-5-20 through 17-5-32); and

WHEREAS, a no-knock warrant allows a law enforcement officer to enter a property without immediate prior notification whether verbal or by knocking or ringing a bell; and

WHEREAS, language in the Georgia statute does not specifically ban the use of no-knock warrants nor clearly defines what is considered "good faith" in attempting to give verbal notice for entry; and

WHEREAS, during the 2015 - 2016 Georgia General Assembly regular session, legislation to specifically regulate no-knock warrants, which included SB 45, SB 159, and HB 56 were stalled; and

WHEREAS, as the City of Atlanta joins cities around the nation in proposing police reforms, these policy changes must serve to protect all individuals against violent crimes, while also including protections against the use of excessive force often associated with the use of no-knock warrants and other police practices; and

WHEREAS, in the State of Georgia, tragedies associated with the execution of no-knock warrants include the 2006 shooting and death of 92 year old Kathryn Johnson, the 2006 killing of a 36 year old Bibb County deputy sheriff, and the 2014 injury of a 19-month old toddler in Habersham County when a stun grenade was used during a no-knock entry; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 a middle aged Houston couple and their dog was killed and recently, on March 13, 2020 in Louisville, KY 26 year-old Breonna Taylor was killed in her apartment after the execution of a "No-Knock" warrant; and

WHEREAS, according to the Cato Institute in Washington, 40 innocent people have died during the execution of no-knock warrants since the 1980s, with Breonna Taylor being the most recent casualty; and

WHEREAS, banning no-knock warrants should include the adoption of specific statutory protocols requiring Georgia Certified Peace Officers to do the following upon the execution of a warrant:

- 1) Physically knock on an entry door to the premises in a manner and duration that can be heard by the occupants.
- 2) Clearly and verbally announce as law enforcement having a search warrant in a manner than can be heard by the occupants.
- 3) Require that body cameras must be activated during the execution of a search warrant and all officers present in the execution of a warrant shall be equipped with an operating body camera.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY Of ATLANTA GEORGIA, to urge that the Georgia General Assembly review and revise its statutes related to searches with warrants, (Title 17, Chapter 5, Article 2, Sections 17-5-20 through 17-5-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated) to specifically ban the use of "no-knock" warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, banning no-knock warrants should include the adoption of specific statutory protocols requiring Georgia Certified Peace Officers to do the following upon the execution of a warrant:

- 1) Physically knock on an entry door to the premises in a manner and duration that can be heard by the occupants.
- 2) Clearly and verbally announce as law enforcement having a search warrant in a manner than can be heard by the occupants.
- 3) Require that body cameras must be activated during the execution of a search warrant and all officers present in the execution of a warrant shall be equipped with an operating body camera.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, the Municipal Clerk shall provide copies to all the members of the Georgia General Assembly.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
