****A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS ANDREA L. BOONE, JOYCE M. SHEPERD, CLETA WINSLOW, DUSTIN R. HILLIS, MICHAEL JULIAN BOND, ANTONIO BROWN, CARLA SMITH, MARCI COLLIER OVERSTREET, ANDRE DICKENS, MATT WESTMORELAND, AMIR R. FAROKHI, JENNIFER IDE AND J.P. MATZIGKEIT URGING THE GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ADOPT HOUSE BILL 1203 REPEALING ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 17 OF THE OFFICIAL GEORGIA CODE AND AMENDING TITLES 17, 35 AND 43 TO PROHIBIT ARRESTS BY PRIVATE PERSONS OR OTHER AUTHORITIES NOT IDENTIFIED AS A PEACE OFFICER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.(FAVORABLE BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE 9/28/20)

WHEREAS, Since 1863, Georgia law has given citizens the authority to arrest one another if they witness or have immediate knowledge that a crime has been committed; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to § 17-4-60 of the Georgia Code, "a private person may arrest an offender if the offense is committed in his presence or within his immediate knowledge. If the offense is a felony and the offender is escaping or attempting to escape, a private person may arrest him upon reasonable and probable grounds of suspicion". The statute also states that the private citizen may deliver the offender to the peace officer, who holds no liability for a false arrest; and

WHEREAS, the citizen's arrest law has far outlived its necessity, when during colonial times, it could have taken days for law enforcement to arrive at a crime scene and private citizens helped to detain suspects while law enforcement had to travel long distances. Now, citizens can dial 911, and the police is dispatched within minutes; and

WHEREAS, history has proven all too many times that individuals with inherent racial and cultural biases have used this law to primarily detain and kill Black people, based solely on suspicions and/or circumstances; and

WHEREAS, undoubtedly, there are hundreds of incidents dating back to the Civil Rights era, where racial bias was the impetus for a citizen's arrest, recent incidents bare truth to this, including the 2019 death of a 62 year-old Black man, Kenneth Herrin, who was killed after he was involved in a minor fender-bender and was pursued by a white motorist, who was not involved in the incident, but attempted to detain him. And, in February 2020, 25-year old Ahmaud Arbery, was pursued, shot, and killed while jogging through a predominantly white neighborhood because he was "suspected" of committing a crime; and

WHEREAS, while there is currently debate going on around the country regarding even the training of law enforcement officers and their perceived racial biases when performing arrests, and excessive use of force against Black individuals, prohibiting "untrained" citizens from attempting to make arrests will save lives; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent on the Georgia General Assembly to support laws which serve to expand and protect all human and civil rights, it must move to purge its books of this and all antiquated laws that are reminiscent of a history that we must never repeat.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Georgia General Assembly adopt House Bill 1203 repealing Article 4, Chapter 4, Title 17 of the Official Georgia Code and amend Titles 17, 35 and 43 to prohibit arrests by private persons or other authorities not identified as a peace officer, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution, upon adoption, to Governor Brian Kemp and all members of the Georgia General Assembly.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
