WHEREAS, under the authority of Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VI of the Constitution of the State of Georgia the City, by Ordinance, adopted by the City Council on, 2021, has established the Beltline Special Services District; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VI of the Constitution of the State of Georgia the City may by ordinance or resolution levy and collect fees, taxes and assessments within the Beltline Special Services District to pay, wholly or partially, the cost of providing local government services within such district; and

WHEREAS, at this time the Department of Finance desires to establish a rate of special service district ad valorem taxes on tangible property within the Beltline Special Services District.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 146-26 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta be amended adding at the end thereof a new subsection (h) to read as follows:

The tax commissioners of Fulton County and DeKalb County, by copy of this section, are requested to specifically list the levy set forth in this subsection on tax bills to be rendered to citizens and taxpayers of the city."						
	SECTION 2: This ordinance shall stand repealed on the earlier of, 2051 or the date on which all bonds, the security for which is the contract approved in Ordinance, are retired.						
	SECTION 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are waived to the extent of such conflict.
