



Proposed Budget Changes



Personnel Budget Changes

- \$13.4M REDUCTION IN PERSONNEL BUDGET
- Transfer personnel to Corrections and Community Services.
- Net increase of thirteen positions driven by transfer of funding to General Fund from the special events trust account and transition of some cultural affairs contract employees.

Operating Budget Changes

- \$128,000 INCREASE IN **OPERATING BUDGET**
- Transfer of Everbridge contract from the Department of Customer Service to the Executive Offices.
- Slight increase to anticipate for higher usage of motor/fuel and repair/maintenance expenses.


