National Emergency Grant (NEG)

- Designed to aid dislocated, underemployed or unemployed jobseekers impacted by COVID-19
- Fulfilled through Work Experience assignments at nonprofit or government agencies
- Must be a City of Atlanta resident to qualify or laid off by an employer within the City of Atlanta
 - 17 Virtual Informational sessions were held between September – February. (Sessions were held twice per month) Sessions will continue on this bi-weekly schedule until all slots are filled.
 - 73 attendees to date
 - 13 Approved Participants
 - Average wage for WEX participants is \$16 per hour.
 - Targeted outreach to multiple agencies

- Over 400 plant workers to be laid off by 6/17/2021
- WSA provided information of our services at the plant in April for services for dislocated (laid off) workers.
- WSA/Invest Atlanta participated in the Job Fair on May 26, 2021.
- Over 75 Mondelez employees registered for WSA employment and training services.


Georgia Tech

- WorkSource Atlanta has received monitoring reports from TCSG and KPMG.
- WorkSource Atlanta participated and co-facilitated WARN workshops for Georgia Tech, and Macys for their recent layoffs. WorkSource Atlanta and Invest Atlanta work together to assist the Mondelez employees who were dislocated.
- WorkSource Atlanta is currently accepting business applications for On-the-Job Training and the Incumbent Worker Training programs.
- WorkSource Atlanta will open the process to add new training providers to our ETPL within the next 30 Days.
- Our One-Stop Operator has facilitated workshops among several community partners that included interviewing skills, resume preparation and career pathways for youths.
