Driving Under the Influence (DUI)

It is a crime in the State of Georgia to operate a vehicle while impaired by alcohol, drugs, or medication



#### **DUI CASES ARE COMPLEX IN NATURE**


- 5 separate subsections in the state statute that constitute the offense of DUI
- Require Expert <u>Legal Knowledge</u> of statues that may precipitate a traffic stop and issues of: Search & Seizure, Due Process, Illegal Interrogation, Right to Counsel
- <u>Scientific Knowledge</u> of Biology, Chemistry, Physiology, Toxicology
- <u>Technical Knowledge</u> of Breath Testing Equipment, Hospital Testing Equipment, Blood Testing Equipment, Forensic Laboratory Equipment
- Multiple license suspension consequences



The Active Caseload of the Public Defender currently is 900+

(COA Public Defender has the largest DUI practice in the State of Georgia)

### Counseling and Treatment Referrals

#### The Process

- Upon Initial Intake <u>ALL</u> Clients Receive a Psychosocial Assessment
- Attorney Identifies Need for Treatment and/or Counseling
- Advocate Determines Resource Needs
- Social Worker Prepares Independent Assessment for Community Partner Referral

# Office of the Public Defender DUI Division Client Success Story

- Client had 4 prior DUI convictions in 3 different states
- Received 5<sup>th</sup> DUI arrest and was appointed to the Public Defender for representation
- At the time of arrest Client was experiencing homelessness
- After initial intake Client was referred to Public Defender social services staff
- Social Worker facilitated Client's enrollment in recovery and treatment
- Today Client is gainfully employed, has an apartment, is reunified with family, and has been sober for over a year
