








## COMPLAINT INTAKE vs. COMPLAINT RESOLUTION







### VIOLENT CRIME CODE ENFORCEMENT INSPECTIONS



 October 2020, a proactive inspection initiative was formulated to assist in fighting violent crime

•136 proactive inspections have been conducted in response to violent crimes that occurred

- 44 violations have been discovered and notices processed
- No code violations were located at 92 of the locations

## REMOVAL OF JUNKED VEHICLES FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY









- 29 Junked Vehicles Towed
- 97 placarded vehicles complied (registered or removed)
- Majority vehicles towed from Districts 9 and 10
- Citations issued for vehicles not easily accessible to placard
  - Covered with tarp/car cover
  - Located behind gate/fence

- 13 Demolition Orders Executed since July 1
- 74 Demolition Projects Awarded to City Contractors
  - · Pending Permit Issuance
- Over 200 Orders Pending Award
  - Pending local and state

#### **Clean and Close Activity**

13 Clean and Close Orders Executed since July 1

#### **Clean and Cut Activity**

- 41\* clean and cut projects executed
- 10 clean and cut projects pending (all scheduled to be resolved by the Department of Corrections-Inmate Detail)
