

Affordable housing Pipeline


Affordable Units

321 units

2021 closed to date: 216 units

Expected to close by end of 2021: additional 366 units

2021 actual (expected): 582 units

Developer: Rea Ventures, LLC & Atlanta Housing

100% affordable – 116 units

- 29 units @ or below 30% AMI
- 63 units @ or below 60% AM
- 24 units @ or below 80% AMI

Closing expected in December 2021 with construction to start shortly thereafter.

Skyline Apartments

1090 Hank Aaron Drive (Peoplestown)

Developer: Exact Capital Group, LLC.

100% affordable

- 250 units @ or below 60% AMI
 - 46 studios
 - 101 1-bedroom
 - 103 2-bedroom

Closing expected December 2021 with construction to start shortly thereafter.

31-acre site purchased in June 2021 (Historic Westin Heights/Bankhead)

- First community meeting held
 June 2021
- Additional community engagement and economic feasibility study being planned for 2022

RFP for Purchase/ Redevelopment expected 2022

- Focus on sustainable living-wage jobs accessible to surrounding neighborhood residents; affordable housing; green space; innovative site design
- Community feedback being incorporated – stakeholder advisory committee and community meetings held in October and November

Invest Atlanta and Atlanta BeltLine, Inc. reviewing responses






Special Service District Funding

- Upcoming community meeting on December 6, 2021











Grand opening of Southside Trail – Segment 1 October 12, 2021
