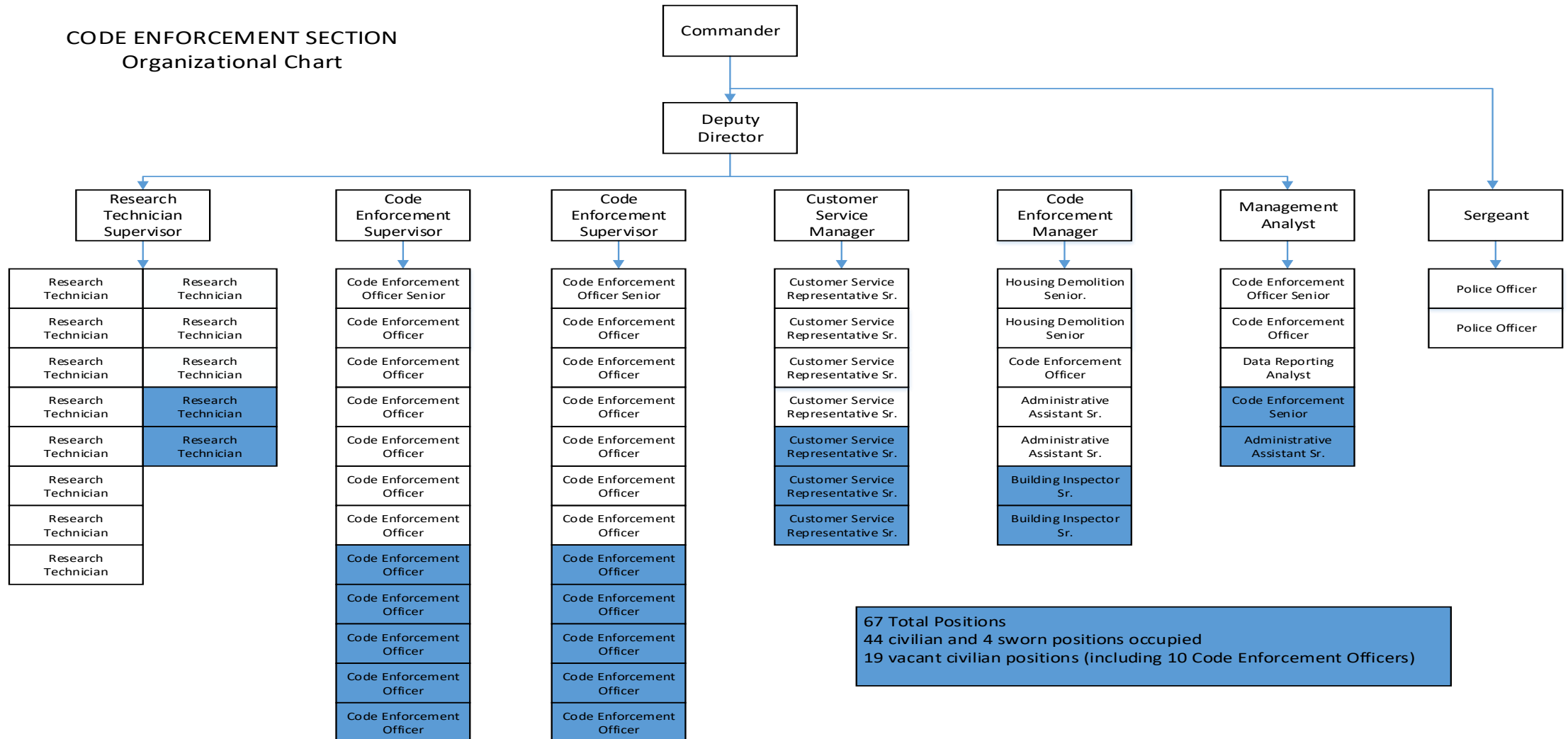

Organizational Chart

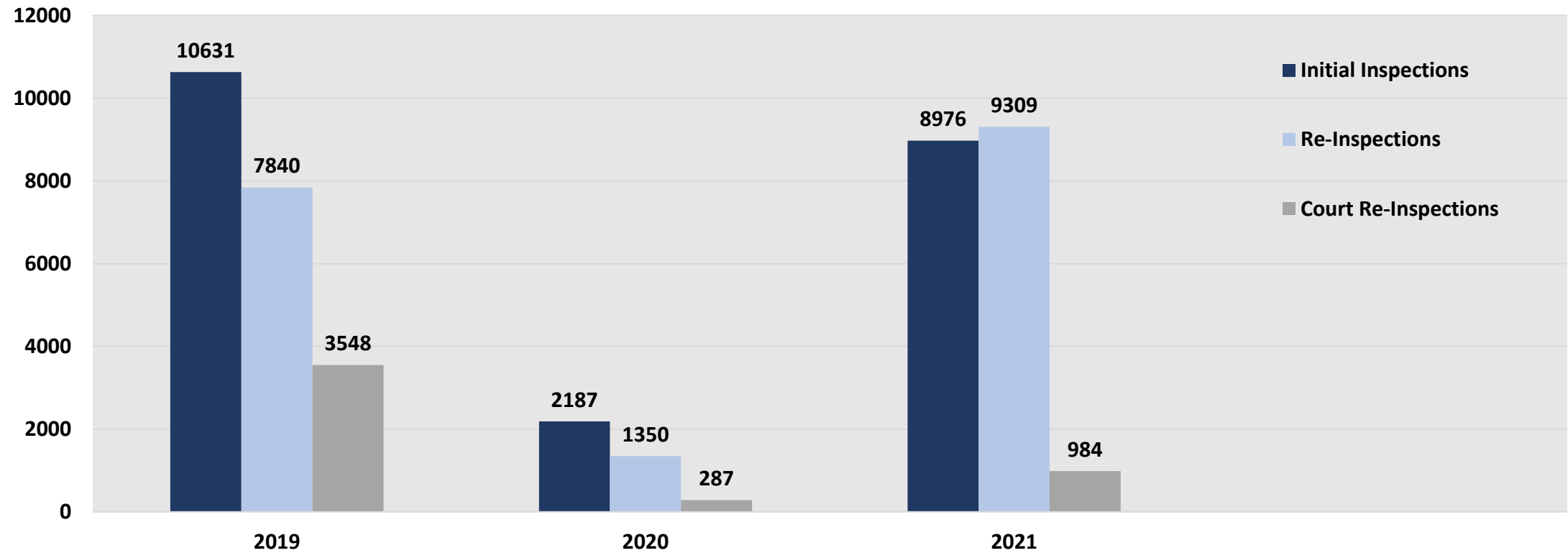


67 Total Positions

19 vacant civilian positions (including 10 Code Enforcement Officers)



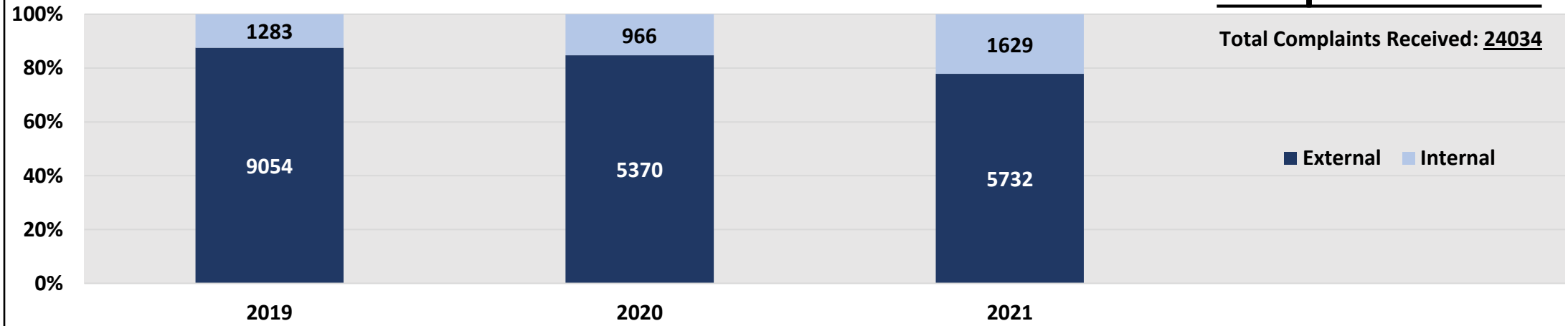

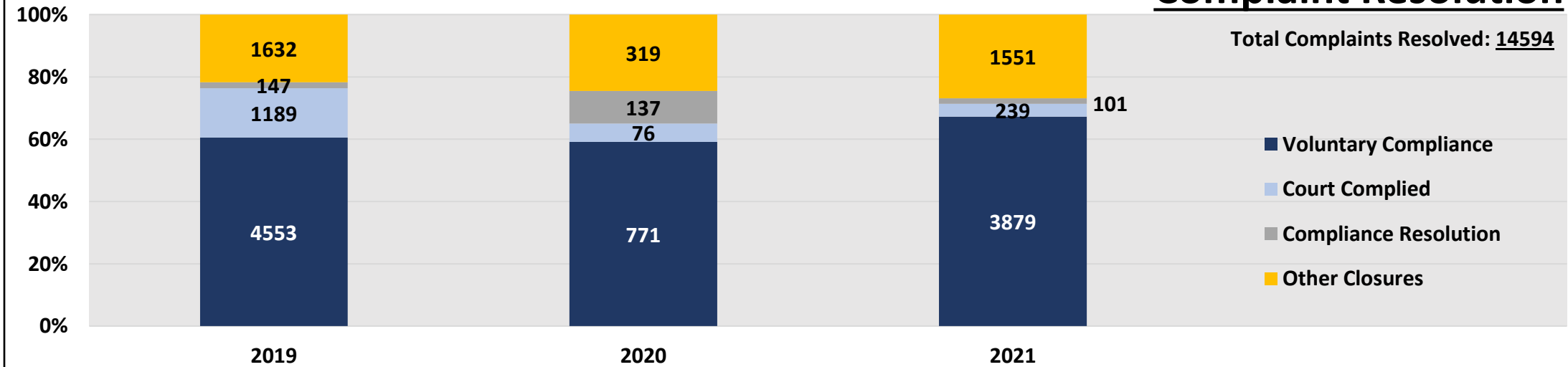




Complaint Intake

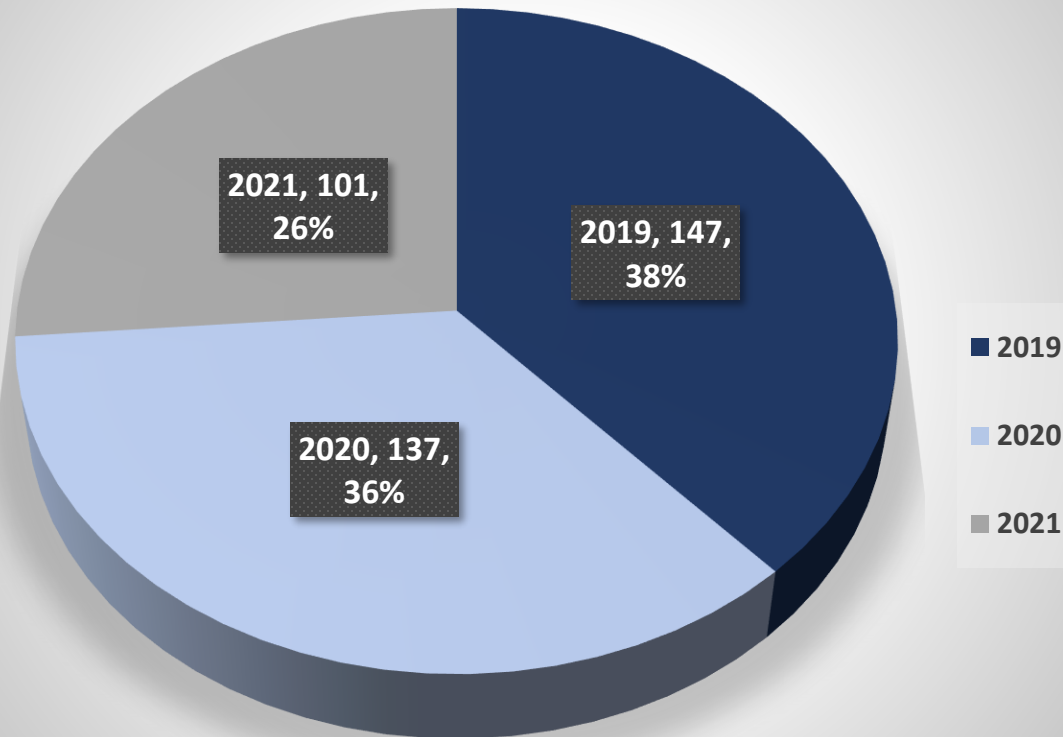
REMOVAL of JUNKED VEHICLES from PRIVATE PROPERTY



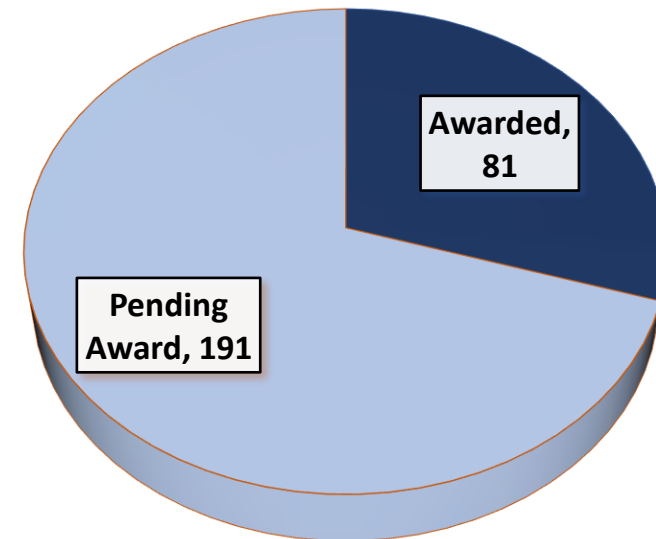
- 35 Junked Vehicles towed to date
