Staffing Challenges:

- Recruitment and retention – 32 vacancies
- Retention on evening shift – more than double resigned from evening than overnight
- Scheduling shifts that are desirable to employees

Short-term plan

- Six employees currently working part-time
- Five employees currently working post-retirement
- Conduct weekly watch representative meetings, which improve communication

Long-term plan

- Create recruitment/retention incentive
- Increase shift differential pay for evening shift, which has highest call volume
- Assess whether the pay study, implemented in 2021, is still competitive
