#### SOMEONE CARES ATLANTA

Offers HIV testing to interested detainees once weekly. Provides Wholeness Health and Wellness to Department of Corrections' population.

#### **Emory Mental Health**

Mental Health services provided to detainees in collaboration with Emory/Grady Fellows from the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences of Emory University School of Medicine.

#### **Viral Solutions**

Founded to help alleviate the COVID testing and vaccination crisis in Georgia. Provides COVID-19 testing and vaccinations to the Department of Corrections' (DOC) detainees and staff.

#### NAVICA APP

The Department of Corrections, along with Atlanta Fire Rescue Department (AFRD), supports the City of Atlanta through training employees on conducting Rapid COVID testing using the NAVICA APP. Atlanta City Detention Center (ACDC) is listed as a (2<sup>nd</sup> standing) COVID testing site for the City of Atlanta in the Fulton County System.







# **Projects**

Warming Centers: The City of Atlanta Department of Corrections partnered with the City of Atlanta Department of Emergency Management to prepare and deliver meals to the designated locations for displaced citizens. On average, DOC prepared and delivered 100 meals per Center per activation. For the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY22, DOC prepared and delivered a total <u>6,800 meals</u> and cleaned <u>272 bags of linen</u>.
